

35,320 illegals vetted under 6P programme

KUALA LUMPUR: A total of 35,323 illegals were checked in Operation 6P by the Immigration Department.

From the figure, 823 illegals and four employers were charged in court; 580 illegals were deported; 257 illegals and 24 employers issued compounds while 1,452 illegals and 52 employers were still under investigation, said Home Ministry secretary-general Tan Sri Mahmood Adam.

"A total of 341,956 illegals have undergone the process of legalisation and pardon. Another 26,760 employers have turned up at eight 6P Programme one-stop centres since the legalisation process started on Oct 10 last year," he said in a statement yesterday.

The Home Ministry had started enforcement of the legalisation process under the 6P Programme, which ended on Jan 10. — Bernama
