

RECIPROCAL GREEN LANE (RGL)

- All nationalities resided in Singapore for short-term business and official purpose – max 14 days of stay.
- RGL will be launched between airports in Malaysia and Singapore which have available non-stop flight routes, as well as between Singapore and Johor via BSI and KSAB.
- Applicant must remain in Singapore for at least 14-day prior to departure to Malaysia.
- Sponsor (Government agency/ company/ organization/ receiving enterprise) to apply for invitees/ participants.
- Eligible quota is 400 per-week.

PERIODIC COMMUTING ARRANGEMENT (PCA)

- Singaporean and Permanent Resident (PR) of Singapore who holds Malaysia's Long Term Social Visit Pass (LTSVP) for working purpose – 3-month of working period and 2-4 weeks of relief period in Home country.
- Restricted to BSI and KSAB land checkpoints with Singapore only.
- Employer to apply for employee.
- Eligible quota is 2,000 per-day.

• **Pre-Departure (Application Process)**

1. Sponsor/ receiving enterprise applies for *MyTravelPass* (MTP) <http://www.mtp.imi.gov.my/> online **at least 10-working day** before departure date. Sponsor to upload the following documents:
 - (a) Sponsor's letter of invitation;
 - (b) Traveller's passport copy; and
 - (c) Travel itinerary - flight/ vehicle & accommodation bookings info.
2. MTP (approval) will be issued (online) **3-day** before

• **Pre-Departure (Application Process)**

1. Employer applies for *MyTravelPass* (MTP) <http://www.mtp.imi.gov.my/> online **at least 10-working day** before departure date. Employer to upload the following documents:
 - (a) Employer's letter of appointment;
 - (b) Employee's passport copies; and
 - (c) Travel itinerary - flight/ vehicle & accommodation bookings info.

- **Returning to Singapore**

Travellers will be subjected to the prevailing health policy for incoming travellers upon return to Singapore.

- **Application to Return to Country of Work**

1. Travellers will be subjected to health screening at the Point of Entry.
2. Travellers will be subjected to a modified Home Surveillance Order (HSO) for 7 days.
3. Travellers will undertake COVID-19 RTK Antibody test at the end of HSO and will be released from HSO if tested negative.
4. Travellers must subscribe to MySejahtera mobile application.

IMPORTANT NOTES

1. APPLICATION FOR PERIODIC COMMUTING ARRANGEMENT (PCA) BY CITIZENS AND PERMANENT RESIDENTS OF MALAYSIA

- Citizens and permanent residents of Malaysia who hold a long-term visas for business or work purposes in Singapore who wish to apply for Periodic Commuting Arrangement (PCA), please refer to Singapore's SafeTravel website at www.safetravel.ica.gov.sg

2. REQUIREMENTS FOR MALAYSIAN WORKERS RETURNING FOR SHORT-TERM HOME LEAVE IN MALAYSIA

- Travellers must subscribe to MySejahtera mobile application
- Travellers will be subjected to post-arrival COVID-19 PCR test in Malaysia
- If tested negative, travelers will be exempted from the 14-day Home Surveillance Order (HSO)
