| <p>PREREQUISITES INFO (Who can apply)</p> | <p>Singapore citizens and Permanent Residents of Singapore who hold Long Term Social Visit Pass (LTSVP) for business or work purposes in Malaysia. Or;</p> <p>Singapore citizens who hold Permanent Residents of Malaysia and who want to re-enter Malaysia for work purposes;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• After entering Malaysia, the employee should work at least three (3) consecutive months in Malaysia before returning to Singapore for short term home leave and subsequently re-entering Malaysia again.• Travellers will bear the cost of COVID-19 test.• Travellers must install, register and activate MySejahtera mobile application before departure.• For travel via land border crossings between Singapore and Malaysia only. |
| <p>APPLICATION PROCESS</p> | <p>MyTravelPass:</p> <p>The employer shall apply for MyTravelPass (MTP) for the employee to enter/ re-enter Malaysia.</p> <p>The employer shall apply on behalf of the employee, via MyTravelPass online (https://mtp.imi.gov.my/) application at least 10-working day before the date of departure from Singapore to Malaysia or returning to Malaysia (to resume work) after a short-home leave</p> <p>The employer needs to provide the following documents:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Copy of valid Long Term Social Visit Pass (LTSVP) for Singapore citizens and Permanent Residents of Singapore• Copy of Permanent Residents of Malaysia (for Singapore citizens only)• Letter of appointment / invitation (for work and official purposes); and• Copy of passport <p>Sponsor to provide traveller’s certificate of having tested negative via COVID-19 PCR test (test to be taken at least within 72 hours before departure).</p> <p>MTP (approval) will be issued (via e-mail) 72 hours before departure date.</p> |

| | <p><u>Arrival in Malaysia</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Travellers must check-in MySejahtera mobile application upon arrival at respective point of entry. • Traveller to present passport and MTP Approval during immigration clearance at point of entry. • Travellers will be subjected to health screening at the Point of Entry. • Travellers will be subjected to the quarantine period set by the relevant agency and cost will be fully borne by applicant. • All travellers are subjected to effective immigration procedures, rules and regulations during immigration clearance at point of entry. |
| <p>RETURNING TO COUNTRY OF WORK (AFTER SHORT-HOME LEAVE)</p> | <p><u>Returning to Malaysia</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The employer shall apply for MyTravelPass (MTP) for the employee to re-enter Malaysia. • Travellers will be subjected to health screening at the Point of Entry. • Travellers will be subjected to the quarantine period set by the relevant agency and cost will be fully borne by applicant. • Travellers must check-in MySejahtera mobile application upon arrival at respective point of entry. |

TRAVELLING FROM SINGAPORE TO MALAYSIA

IMPORTANT NOTE

1. APPLICATION FOR PERIODIC COMMUTING ARRANGEMENT (PCA) BY CITIZENS AND PERMANENT RESIDENTS OF MALAYSIA

- Citizens and permanent residents of Malaysia who hold a long-term visas for business or work purposes in Singapore who wish to apply for Periodic Commuting Arrangement (PCA), please refer to Singapore's SafeTravel website at <https://safetravel.ica.gov.sg>

2. REQUIREMENTS FOR MALAYSIAN WORKERS RETURNING FOR SHORT-TERM HOME LEAVE IN MALAYSIA

- To obtain PCA Pass from Singapore Authority as a proof during immigration clearance at Malaysian Point of Entry.

- Travellers must install, register and activate [MySejahtera](#) mobile application before departure.
 - Travellers to undertake COVID-19 PCR test within 24 hours post-arrival in Malaysia, at own cost.
 - While waiting for the COVID-19 PCR test result, traveler is required to self-isolate and adhere to the health guidelines set by Ministry of Health Malaysia.
3. A non-Malaysian traveller is required to bear the cost of Covid-19 test before arrival in Malaysia. Please refer to URL link below to make payment. <https://safetravel.myeg.com.my>
